A distributed operating system is a software over a collection of independent, networked, communicating, and physically separate computational nodes which handle jobs which are serviced by multiple cpus. each individual node holds a specific software subset of the global aggregate operating system. In 1948, financed by the air force, the bureau began design and construction of seac, the standards eastern automatic computer. seac went into operation in may 1950 using a combination of vacuum tubes and solid-state diode logic.
