The first continental congress met in carpenter's hall in philadelphia, from september 5, to october 26, 1774. carpenter's hall was also the seat of the pennsylvania congress. all of the colonies except georgia sent delegates. The first continental congress was a meeting of delegates from twelve of the thirteen colonies who met from september 5 to october 26, 1774, at carpenters' hall in philadelphia, pennsylvania, early in the american revolution. The first continental congress met in carpenter's hall in philadelphia, from september 5, 1774 until october 26, 1774. the meeting was called in response to acts of the british parliament, collectively known in the colonies as the intolerable acts.
