Chapter 1 : Elements Political Economy Wayland Francis Gould

The elements of political economy by Francis Wayland, D.D., late president of Brown University, and professor of moral philosophy for forty years. The religious faith in which Wayland was brought up was Calvinist, sectarian, and evangelical. His father and mother immigrated from England to America in 1793, and they brought their Baptist faith with them. The Elements of Moral Science (1863) was never as popular as Wayland's textbook on economics, the Elements of Political Economy, which is still a classic that deserves consideration two centuries later. First published in 1837, the Elements of Political Economy was published soon afterward (1841) in abridged and revised editions. a
