Get this from a library! the islar, a narrative of lang iii.. [mark saxton; austin tappan wright](mark saxton was the one who compiled and edited and published islandia from wright's notes.) the story follows lang iii, the grandson of john lang from the original novel. islandia is under great pressure from outside governments to modernize.

There are also three sequels/prequels, all written by mark saxton, the islar, islandia today - a narrative of lang iii. published 1969, this book is set in the then-present day.
