Katherine Paterson (born October 31, 1932) is a Chinese-born American writer best known for children's novels. Four different books published 1975-1980, she won two Newbery medals and two National Book Awards. She is one of three people to win the two major international awards; for "lasting contribution to children's literature" she won the biennial Hans Christian Andersen Award. *Jacob Have I Loved* is a children's novel by Katherine Paterson published by Crowell in 1980 and it won the annual Newbery Medal the next year. The title refers to the sibling rivalry between Jacob and Esau in the Jewish and Christian Bible, and comes directly from Romans 9:13: "as it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated." The novel follows the story of the Bradshaws, a family on an Amazon farm: Jacob, Bridget Fonda, Jenny Robertson, John Kellogg, Laura Innes, Evan Mirand, Mary Fogarty, Lonny Price, Mary Starnes, Johnny E.
