James Fenimore Cooper (September 15, 1789 – September 14, 1851) was an American writer of the first half of the 19th century. His historical romances draw a picture of frontier and American Indian life in the early American days which created a unique form of American literature. He lived most of his life in Cooperstown, New York, which was founded by his father William on property that he owned. James Fenimore Cooper [pseudonym Jane Morgan] (1789-1851), American author and critic wrote the last of the Mohicans (1826); "where are the blossoms of those summers!--fallen, one by one; so all of my family departed, each in his turn, to the land of spirits. James Fenimore Cooper (1789-1851) was one of the most popular American novelists of his time and he gained a great deal of fame both in America and abroad with his romantic tales of adventure. It is the second book of the Leatherstocking Tales pentalogy and the best known to contemporary audiences. The Pathfinder, published 14 years later in 1840, is its sequel. The Last of the Mohicans is set in 1757, during the French and Indian War (the Seven Years' War), when France and Great Britain were at war.
